MEDAL OF MEDALS TROPHY 2022 TERMS OF COMPETITION

EVENT:

The Medal of Medals will be contested each calendar year on a date scheduled after all Club Medal rounds have been completed.

COMPETITION:

The competition is a Stroke round over 18 holes, held in conjunction with the daily Stroke event open to all women members.

ELIGIBILITY:

Players who have won a club medal during the calendar year, in any division, are eligible to play for this Medal. (Usually, six club medal rounds are held each year, in three divisions.)

TIES:

In the event of a tie after the round is played, a playoff to determine the winner will take place, **AFTER ALL THE FIELD HAS COMPLETED 18 HOLES**. The Playoff will be a "Sudden Death" playoff on Hole 18 until a result is reached.

DISPUTES:

Any dispute arising must be referred to the Match Committee immediately. The winner will not be announced until the Match Committee has made its decision.

Carts are allowed. Caddies are not permitted.

PROVIDED THE COURSE IS OPEN, THE EVENT WILL BE HELD AS SCHEDULED.

WINNER:

The winner is the player with the BEST NETT OVERALL SCORE ON THE DAY.
Only one medal is awarded across the field.

TROPHY:

The winner will receive the Silver **MEDAL OF MEDALS** on the day of play, if possible.
Her name will also be entered on the Honour Board in the Club.

The competition is conducted under the R & A Rules of Golf.
